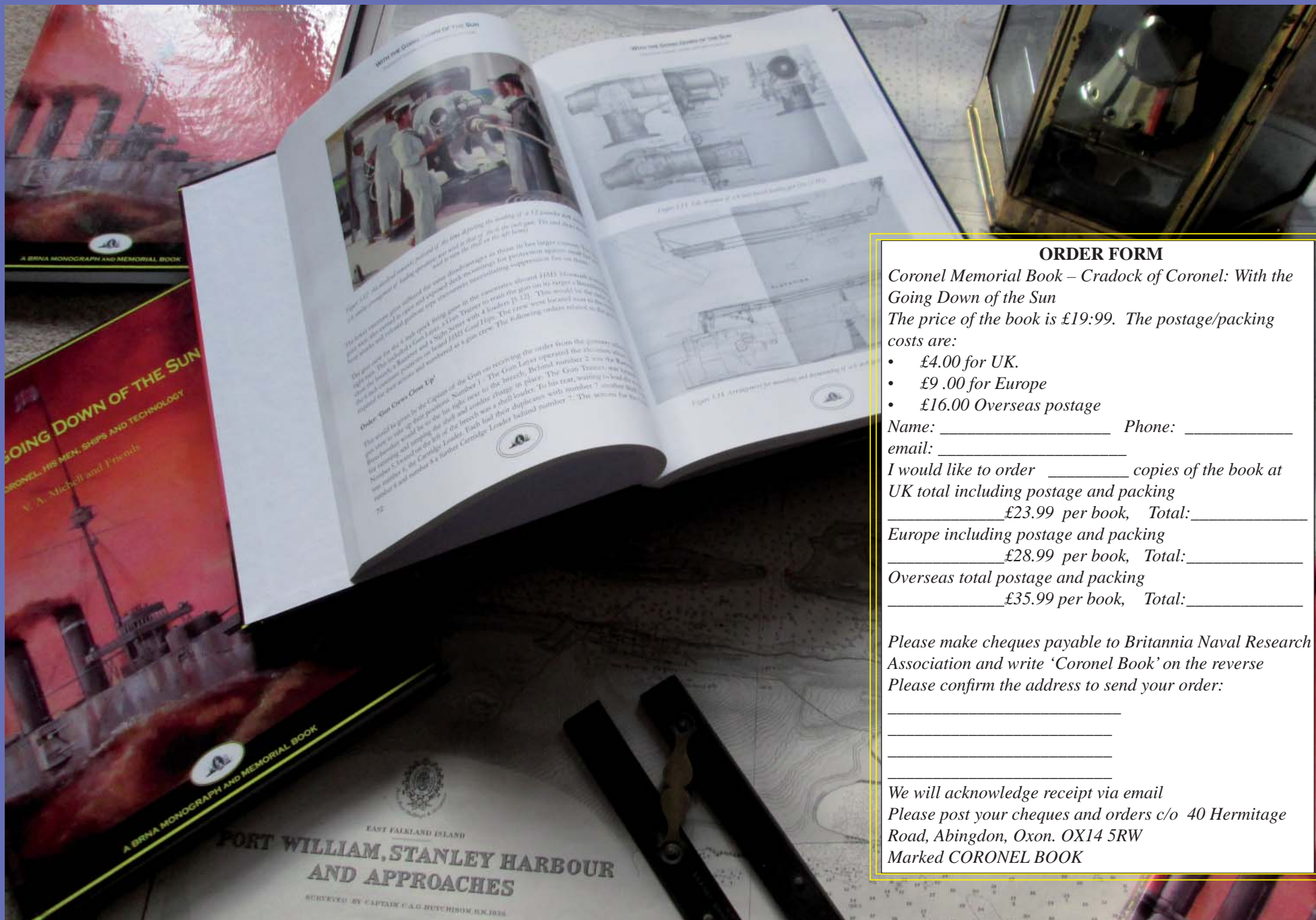

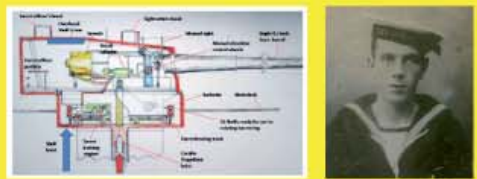
### 'The Saddest Naval Event of the First World War'
